Dear Fellow Trustees

I would ask you to accept this letter as my formal resignation as a trustee of the Willand Health & Community Centre Charity, with immediate effect. The main reasons are:

Over the last twelve months the volume of work expected from me has become overwhelming, and is now impacting on my family and private life, which of course is unacceptable

There is also the intransigence demonstrated by the Willand Parish Council refusing to consider reasonable requests from the trustees to have the lease altered to allow the trustees to sign it. Which leads me to believe, that there has never really been the support for the project to build the new Health & Community Centre.

Further, the adoption by the Parish Council to consider proposals from the pre-school to develop the whole of the Gables site, leaving only a small area available to accommodate the Willand Health & Community Centre, leaves me with no appetite to continue with the project.

I would like to put on record that I have enjoyed being involved with the Trustees in the project to design and build the new Health & Community Centre, it has been both challenging and stimulating and I hope I have contributed some drive and energy, and a little expertise to bring it to its current stage

Perhaps this is the time for someone else to join the Charity bringing new ideas, experience, thoughts and some fresh stimulus.

Recognising that the project still has some difficult times ahead, I can only wish that it can be brought to a satisfactory completion.
