**MINUTES OF DRIVING SPEEDS DOWN IN DEVON SUB-COMMITTEE  
MONDAY 18 SEPTEMBER 1995**

1. **Minutes** of the meeting on 21 August had been passed at the Council meeting on 14 September.

**2. Traffic Survey**

Councillor Dennis reported the survey had been undertaken by himself and Councillor Steele. The average of vehicles exceeding the speed limit was 18.3% with the highest recorded speed of 72 mph, commercial vehicles in the main kept to speed limit. The percentage recorded meant we had a problem with speeding but it was not massive.

It was decided that an analysis of the figures should be produced. In the meantime, the booklet should be issued to all houses, with the Public Meeting notice.

It was noted that unlike other villages we had no flashing school lights or warning signs on the main road. The clerk was to follow these items up.
