#### PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S NOTES

We have passed the longest day and the days will begin to become shorter from now on. The school holidays are approaching and one hopes that the children and young people will enjoy the facilities of the village without feeling the need to cause damage and further expense for the council tax payers of the village. The wanton damage to the dog bin by the Gables Lea entrance of the Jubilee Field has been put right with the provision of a new bin that will take any litter, including dog waste, so please use it responsibly. The total cost for the bin and the work to remove the old and fit the new came to £422.29 that need never have had to be paid out by the Parish. If anyone has a guilty conscience the Clerk will be only too happy to receive payment from the offenders. I know – some hope – but there is no harm in dreaming.

On the subject of recreation and play areas, as I write this the finishing touches have been put to the play area off Chestnut drive. There is a small climbing combination for the little ones, a roundabout for wheel chair users or even little ones in prams and then there are swings for little ones and the bigger ones. There is a seat for 'granny' to sit on and watch and a litter bin but please do not put dog mess in the bin in the play area. A larger area has been covered with safety surface and so hopefully the muddy areas will be reduced.

Hopefully work will start on replacing the BMX dirt track with a Pump Track in the Jubilee Field. Work is scheduled to start on the 9<sup>th</sup> August 2023 so that area of the field will be fenced off for safety. We would like to have had it ready for the summer holidays but sadly we have to fall in with the work programme of the contractors and believe it or not many were not interested in the work. We are also preparing for quotes and planning to replace the skateboard area with a larger and more solid structure but that will be a few months away yet. We are also in the process of acquiring a wheel chair friendly picnic bench to place in the field near to the other benches and hopefully this will create a family or party area. This will hopefully help as we oldies will be able to sit and talk and the youngsters can run around and use all the kit in the field.

Now we have a problem with which we need some help please. We should have 12 Parish Councillors and we now only have 7. We need a minimum of 4 to form a quorum to make decisions. Sadly, Lisa Mastrolacasa has had to tender her resignation due to work and child care issues. Lisa will be a great loss as although she has not been able to get to meetings since the birth of her daughter she has always been on the end of the telephone and able to contribute to various discussions. Thank you, Lisa for your contribution to our community and we hope to see you again if circumstances permit in the future. As a rule, we now only have one meeting a month with none in August. There will be a second meeting in December to set the budget and precept for the next financial year. If you are interested in helping your community and can find three or four hours a month – half of that at home reading things – please get in touch with the Clerk. If you want to find out more information, please feel free to give me a call.

We have had no rain and then the grass and shrubs are not growing and even dying and now we have the rain back but that will mean that things start to grow and footpaths get obstructed together with potential slip area hazards. In spite of expectations the Parish Council do not have any statutory powers to make a land owner do anything. If the problem is caused from Parish owned or managed land it is dealt with. We do write to householders and other businesses and authorities seeking their cooperation but if they do not respond positively, we have to refer it elsewhere for action. Devon County Council are responsible for ensuring that highways and public footpaths are accessible and safe. We do refer to them and they have powers to require landowners to cut back vegetation or make safe and if all else fails the DCC can do the work and charge the house/land owner. Sadly, they seem to have been on an 'excuses' course locally and everything is long winded. Power to the resident who rather robustly took on DCC at the top and got some action out of our Neighbourhood Highways Officer but we will have to wait and see what happens if the landowner does not take action. Thank you to all those who act responsibly by keeping their boundaries tidy and to those who respond positively when approached by the Clerk.

The Neighbourhood Plan is now out for consultation and although the consultation notification and request is in my name that is only 'politics'. The hard work has been done by Stephen Little and his team of volunteers and I thank them for all their time and hard work. I am sure that there will be a separate article on the subject elsewhere in the magazine which will be more informative if you need any help. Please do try and make time to read it and give any feedback as what is in it will affect the village and community for some years to come.

The country and our community are going through difficult and uncertain times with the economy and the cost of living. We are fortunate in that we have the Willand Pantry and we still have a helpline if someone needs help and/or advice. Please do not be too proud to ask if you need help. Please keep an eye on your neighbours, particularly the elderly, if they are on their own. If you are lonely and need to talk to someone then there are various coffee mornings and other functions going on around the village and surrounding area which can be attended for some conversation and company.

I am pleased to say that our revised volunteer team editing the magazine are working well and my thanks to all the team for a job well done. #### WILLAND COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH (WCSW)

The team have been out on the streets since the last update and, sad to report, there is still a high number of drivers exceeding the speed limit. Unfortunately, other than the speeders for whom we record and submit details, we are currently unable to evaluate our effectiveness because the Parish Council still haven't reactivated the VAS box since Councillor Paul Major left the Parish Council at the end of March. As well as moving the VAS box between the opposite ends of Silver Street, Paul sent WCSW the data every month so that we could see whether the speeding numbers were up or down on the previous month and last year.

The subject is due for discussion at tomorrow night's (13 July) Parish Council meeting so, hopefully, by the time you read this, the VAS will be back in action. Mind you, they are also considering whether the VAS should be sold, after buying it with our money. You should also be aware that the Parish Council reluctantly commissioned an independent road safety assessment late last year and accepted the resulting report earlier this year. That report recommended possible solutions to the danger sites around the village, together with costs. Unfortunately, the Parish Council shelved the report 'as there is no money'. I think there should have been a discussion about which solutions might have been possible if some funds could be found/raised. So, that's potentially wasted £3,000 to £4,000 of our money.

We now have some hard facts around safety issues on our roads, including horrendous vehicle speeds, and I believe that we should form a plan to lobby Devon Highways to do something. One possible idea, for example, would be to say you find  $\pounds 5,000$  and the Parish Council will match it. Personally, we believe that, based on their action so far, the Willand Parish Council aren't interested in road safety.

On the positive side, the WCSW team have helped Uffculme to set up a similar team and they successfully held their first live session on 7 July. As always, please stick to the speed limits. **David Marrow, Group Co-ordinator, WCSW**

#### WILLAND HISTORY GROUP

First of all, we would like to thank Geri Holloway for writing to us with some wonderful memories that were stirred by our article in the last parish magazine, describing the opening of the Playing Field in 1937.

These vivid recollections help recreate a snapshot of what Willand was like, and recalls some of the personalities who lived here: "Born in August 1932, I have only vague recollections of Mrs Tracey, a much-respected local dignitary. She lived at the Gables, and sometimes, when I was out for my afternoon walk with my mother in that vicinity, we would meet her in her wheelchair being pushed by Margery, her tall, bespectacled spinster daughter. We would exchange brief greetings, me having been well primed beforehand by my mother to 'say Good afternoon *nicely*'. Afternoon walks for my sister, Pamela, and myself, escorted by our mother, occasionally took us to the Playing Field situated between the rear of Fir Close and South View Road. It had two swings and two seesaws. The bumpy, jerky motion of a seesaw, partnered with my sister, never appealed to me, but I always enjoyed soaring skywards on one of the swings."

"Albert Chick, the village carpenter and a talented musician, was my great uncle, brother of Henry Chick, who was my mother's father. Oswald Little was Albert's son-in-law, having married his daughter, Beatrice. Mr Honeywill lived in a detached house at the station end of Lloyd Maunders Lane. The applause accorded to my father in the formers' speech was well deserved for my father's fund-raising efforts, some of which I can recall. For example, watching him enthusiastically rattling his collection tin among the crowds in the (old) village, gathered to watch the Carnival processions."

"Willand Carnival was a very popular and renowned annual event not only in the village itself but for much of the surrounding area too.

One year, in my early teens, I myself was one of the walking entrants — as a chimney sweep armed with a real brush borrowed from Harry Mortimore, our next-door neighbour, who was the village chimney sweep as well as its postman. My placard, a brief verse composed by my mother, exhorted the hundreds of spectators lining the route:

"The electric sweep saves a lot of fuss, but remember the man with the old-fashioned brush."

The Carnival procession headed by a band (from Tiverton or Wellington?), followed by numerous colourful tableaux and many walking entrants, assembled on the road just beyond The Elms before wending its circuitous way through the (old) village, along Silver Street, South View Road and Station Road to its terminus in the yard adjoining the Assembly Rooms. By the time I had trudged that mile-long route my brush with its metal rod, authentic tool of my adopted trade, slung over my shoulder, weighed very heavy indeed!" Thank you, Geri, for such fantastic memories. If anyone else has similar memories, we would love to hear from you.

At our AGM in June, we discussed the future of Willand History Group and the feasibility of continuing, but unanimously agreed to continue as we are as far as possible. As well as ongoing projects, such as re-organisation and the proper cataloguing of the Willand Archive (any advice or expertise would be gratefully received), new projects were suggested, including looking at the 1921 census for Willand, collecting oral histories from current Willand residents, and taking a more in-depth look at some of Willand's historic buildings. We are also grateful to Brian Holmes – former editor of the Willand Magazine – for kindly donating to us a detailed map of Willand parish (Devon County Council, 2004), which we hope to use as the starting point for a closer look at the parish boundaries, and as a tool to plot some of the recent developments in the parish. However, as a small group, we would always welcome new members, or anyone who would like to help or get involved in any way, develop your own interests or drive new projects. If you think this might be for you, please do get in touch.

#### NOTES FROM THE FIELD: AUGUST

We have reached a turning point in the season with most of the crops now in the ground. At this time of year our work turns from sowing and planting to crop care, weeding and harvesting. August is also the time of year when we'll be sowing green manures, mixes of plants such as clover, chicory, vetch and rye grass that fix nitrogen and improve soil structure, keeping the soil protected over the winter.

August is one of the best times of year for seasonal, local eating. Day length is still long and plant growth is fast, bringing plentiful produce including summer favourites of tomatoes, cucumbers, courgettes, beans, aubergines and soon sweetcorn, as well as kale, chard, salad, beets,



carrots, new potatoes and onions. This year we are growing ten varieties of tomatoes including a mix of cherry tomatoes (Black Cherry, Sakura, Mango Lassi, Santiam Sunrise and Yellow Submarine), salad tomatoes, and beefsteak varieties (Coeur de Boeuf, Mountain Miracle Pink Swarm). There's nothing quite like a slice of beefsteak tomato on toast, sprinkled with sea salt, basil and a drizzle of olive oil to signal that summer is here.

#### **Courgette Gratin**

With an abundance of courgettes, it can be fun to play around with different ways of eating them – grilled, roasted, added to stir fries, frittatas, salads and ratatouilles. The softer skin varieties have great flavour and you won't find them in the supermarkets as they don't transport or store well. This gratin works really well and is a nice one to return to each year when courgettes are in season. It all cooks together in one dish so it's easy to make and works well with a simple side salad.

**Ingredients**: 2 tbsp olive oil, 3 onions finely sliced, 180g basmati rice, 7 medium courgettes sliced, 500ml veg stock, 4 tbsp crème fraiche, 150g grated cheese, salt, pepper, chilli flakes, fresh herbs to taste

Method: - Preheat oven to 190 degrees C

Heat olive oil in a large frying pan, add onions and cook for 20 mins until soft and sticky. - Add sliced courgettes along with rice. Mix and pour in the stock. Turn up heat and cook for 5 mins while stirring. You want the mixture to stay quite loose and oozy, so add a little more stock if needed.

Take pan off heat and stir in crème fraiche plus 100g grated cheese. Add seasoning to taste.

- Transfer to an oiled roasting tray. Make sure the rice is evenly distributed. Roughly flatten and try to get the courgettes on top to help keep the moisture in. Sprinkle on the rest of the cheese. - Bake in the oven for 40 minutes until the top is golden and bubbling and the rice is cooked. #### **DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL**

Members have received regular budget monitoring reports throughout 2022/23 in which budget pressures and risks have been identified. The outturn underspend of £156,000 is achieved after a contribution to the budget management reserve of £1.5 million and a carry forward of £500,000 into 2023/24 for Highways. The final outturn position is an improvement from the £3.6 million overspend forecast outturn which was reported to Cabinet on 8th March and a significant improvement on the £30.5 million forecast overspend at month 2 at which time there was a further £10 million risk identified relating to in year inflationary pressures. The organisational wide response to the financial challenges faced by the authority, resulted in £25.4 million of additional in year savings, income and alternative applications of funding being identified. Delivery of savings and additional income contained within the budget totalled £33.7 million against planned savings of £38.7 million.

Briefing Note / Position Statement from the Director of Children and Young People's Futures recognises the importance of pay awards in helping us to recruit and retain a strong and dedicated workforce, we are concerned that an unfunded pay rise would have significant impact on our maintained schools. The increase of £1,925 for NJC staff along with the proposed 6.5% for teachers represents an additional £13.8 Million in costs to DCC maintained schools in the 2023/24 financial year. This is an average of 7% of total schools funding of £185 Million (calculated as Schools Budget Share plus Mainstream Additional Grant).

Adult Care Operations and Health outturn is £4.8 million overspent, which reflects significant pressure on unit rates and higher residential and nursing placements volumes and complexity present throughout the year. These pressures have been partially offset by one off grant monies and underspends on staffing budgets which reflect the difficulty in recruiting care management staff

Devon County Cabinet are proposing the decommission the Mobile Library vehicles and provide £25K transition support for vulnerable users to continue to access alternative library provision. The Council would provide funding to help with the transition to other existing and new library services to ensure that the most vulnerable members of the mobile library community continue to access services they value. This has now been called to scrutiny for discussion. If scrutiny and make alternative suggestions, Cabinet do not have to except any suggestion/recommendations. The earliest any closure of the mobile library will not come into force is September.

Each of our county councillors has an annual locality budget, to be used as a fund of last resort, of £5,000 that they can use to respond to local needs within any financial year (April to March). Councillors can, if they wish, make grants to support projects or activities that benefit the communities they represent.
