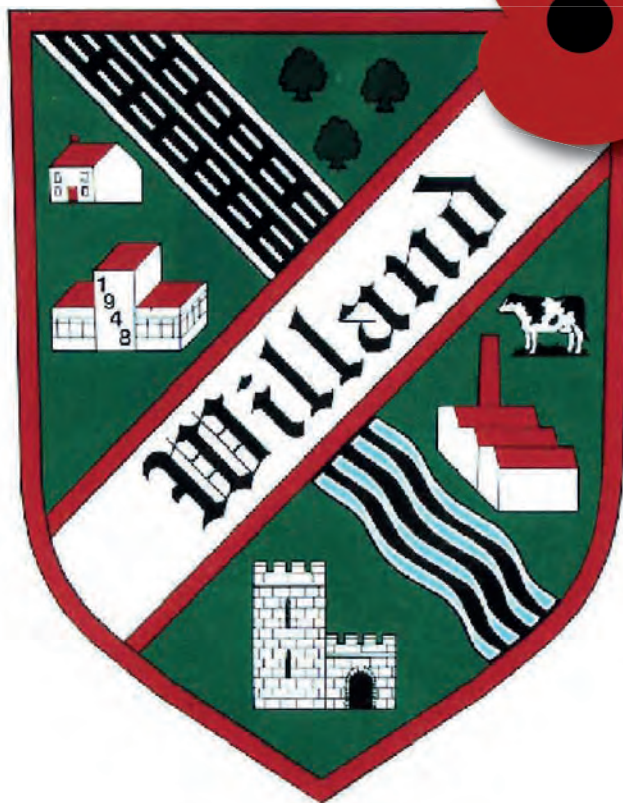

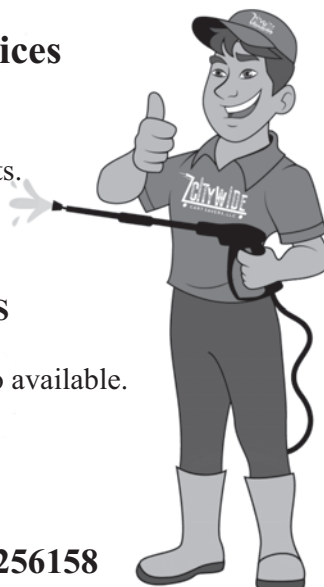

Well, we had a bit of sunshine late this summer (hope you managed to keep cool) Please take care in the darker evenings to come. Guy Fawkes Night comes around again, please have considerations for people's pets when discharging fireworks. The next issue December/January will be delivered around 28th November so please don't forget to include your Christmas plans in your submissions.

PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S NOTES

Let us start with the very good news – well it is for me and hopefully a lot more of the village, particularly the youngsters. The pump track in the Jubilee Field was officially opened on Friday 8 September 2023 by year 6 children of the Primary School thanks to the help of the Headmistress, Anne Hawkins, staff and parents. The fencing had been taken down the afternoon before as that was the only time we could get the workmen to do it. Children came out of school that afternoon and our handyman who was watering the new turf was swamped by lots of school children wanting to get onto the track. We had had problems earlier in the week with some children breaking open the fence at one end and going on the track, obviously something lacking in their upbringing when they do not know the meaning of safety fencing and the words 'Keep Out'. I was amused with some of the excuses/explanations they tried on me. Thirty years in the police force, heard it all before. It is there and for all to use from the littlest one on their trike right up to grownups who are the experts. Please act responsibly, share evenly, and help the less able who want to participate. It can be used by all sorts of bicycles, scooters, skateboards and the like. I am told that rollerblades will also work on it. **No motorcycles or electric scooters please.** Please read the sign and follow the safety advice, particularly the wearing of helmets. Please try and keep off the turf on the banks as some are already wrecking it. One last plea – put your litter in the bin – there are 3 in the field or else take it home. The main thing is to ENJOY.

It was in 2017 that I was involved with a small team in negotiating with developers for contributions towards the village to provide improved facilities to cater for the extra residents likely to come to the community. A lot of money was to go to the Primary School and then there was some for the Community Centre at The Gables and then a big chunk for 'teen facilities' which had a very wide definition but the improvement to the old BMX Track was the priority as it was getting dangerous with various rubbish coming to the surface that had been buried there in the past. Jason Scott, at that time a Parish Councillor, built up a rapport with a group of interested young people and possible uses and designs were discussed. Eventually when Bellway Homes became the final developer of the site in Meadow Park for 125 houses nearly £500,000 became available to be shared among the various agreed projects within the village.

The pump track build was put out to tender and it was designed and built by Forte Trailscapes. The owner of the company is a BMX Champion and so knows what he is doing and most of his team of workers are 'bikers'.

Kai Forte came to the opening and put on a display for the children as to what they can work towards. Thanks to all who have been involved and in particular to the various Parish Clerks [4 in all] who have had to back us up in doing all the paperwork involved.

The next project is to replace the small skateboard ramps with a rather updated concrete half pipe. It has been designed and planning permission is being sought and the specification is out to tender. The money is available and held by Mid Devon District Council until all the applications and information is available and then it will be all systems go. We have also ordered a disabled access picnic bench to go in the field so there will be additional seating for a family gathering or just to sit and watch the children at play.

There will be some money left over if my calculator is right, so please let the Clerk have ideas as to what you would like to see by way of teen facilities – we have a pretty wide definition of ‘teen’ we are using so any ideas are open for consideration, and we are not restricted to the Jubilee Field.

The other good news is that some residents have come forward to be co-opted onto the Parish Council as we are short as reported in the last magazine. We are pleased to welcome Jason Scott back as a councillor. He has been joined by Helen Jones who is known to many for her involvement around the village. It is hoped that in October Sue Leach will also be co-opted as well and a lot of people know Sue for her various involvements. There are still two more vacancies if you would like to become involved in helping your community. If you are over 18 and live in the village you are eligible. If we get more applications than there are vacancies some of us oldies can retire.

As some may know we have a new contractor cutting the grass verges this year and we are assessing the future of the contract as we regularly do. Do you have any thoughts, observations, or suggestions with regard to the verge grass cutting now and in the future. We want to hear from you as the village are paying. Please let the Clerk know. This does not include the areas covered by MDDC as they have reduced the number of cuts by way of savings, and it will show.

The Clerk has chased up some landowners over hedges growing over footpaths and thank you to those who have responded positively and done the job and we are still waiting on some who have promised. We have a bit of a battle with Devon County Highways over one area, but we are persevering.

You may like to watch out for some planning proposals that are hovering about in the system. The 160 acres of solar panels on good agricultural land between Willand and Halberton up through Brithem Bottom is beginning to move again. They are looking to put another large Anaerobic Digester in Halberton which will not directly affect us in relation to noise or odour, but we will be affected by additional traffic on the roads in the area taking more feedstock to and digestate from the site.

There is also an enquiry raising its head to apply to build 170 houses off Muxbeare Lane.

Although the main access looks to be out onto the B3181 just Up past Halfway House. It is in Halberton Parish, but all residents will be using Willand facilities, yet Halberton will get the Council Tax.

The site is not even in the local plan for housing. It is noted that the road layout is marked in two places as identifying access for expansion. Please make sure you make your views known during the consultation period whether you are or against or just have a concern to raise.

People have been asking what is going on along Silver Street with the roadworks. There is a planning requirement for the Meadow Park development to widen the footpath to a legal width where there is no margin between the road and the footpath. Somewhere along the line Devon County seemed to have slipped in some street light work, drainage, and installation of tactile crossings. The way they are working makes me wonder who is overseeing it and paying the bill?

Thank you to all who volunteer and help with all the clubs and projects within the village that contribute to us having a vibrant community. If you are not feeling the benefit, then perhaps you need to get more involved. If you just want to keep yourself to yourself and be left alone then that position is respected. As long as you are aware of the sense of community and help that is out there that is all that matters.

I finish by thanking the Reverend Simon Talbot for all his involvement in the village during his stay with us as our vicar. It has been a pleasure to work with him on occasions for the benefit of our community. I am sure we all wish him and his family all the best in their new life. I know one of his sons hopes to get a ride in a tank. I am sure that Stephen and Paul and others in the Team will look after us as needed. Who said that they had retired. **Barry G J Warren**

Yep, It's Autumn – when the leaves drop down. For your information we accept leaves, - PROVIDING they are not mixed with any other material. When visiting the site with your leaves - please deposit where so directed – thank you. When there is sufficient volume of leaves, they are mown and added to the shredded material. The start of composting.

WE ARE A GREEN COMPOSTING SITE

'Going green' means that we are asking that you only bring green garden waste to the site that is listed on the signs ATTACHED TO THE GATES. To this request we add - No Vegetation with Soil attached. Also, any labels and stones. THIS IS NOT GOOD - bad for the shredder and DON'T COMPOST! If we are unable to receive - see "Recycle Garden Waste" below.

Bags of **Sieved** (with next to no twigs) compost is £2.00/bag.

PLEASE, returning of your empty bags will be gratefully received.

Sieved Waste - this material has been composted then sieved. But because it contains more twigs, we do not offer this as bagged compost. However, we do offer this as mulch at £2.00/wheelbarrow. We have a wheelbarrow. Users say, when dug in and left to winter it improves the soil quality.

Delicata squash has been described as a 'sweet potato' squash as the flavour and texture as the flesh is similar to sweet potato.

Ingredients: butter for cooking, 2 leeks, trimmed and thinly sliced including the green part, a large handful chard/spinach, shredded, 1 teaspoon English mustard, 4 tablespoons crème fraiche, 125g Gruyère or other well-flavoured hard cheese, finely grated, 2 smallish squash or one big one, a handful of thyme sprigs

1. Heat the butter in a saucepan over a medium heat and add the leeks. Leeks don't like to get too hot, so turn the heat down and sweat gently for about 10 minutes until soft. Add the chard/spinach and cook for a further couple of minutes until just wilted. Remove from heat and stir in the crème fraiche, mustard and cheese.
2. Cut the squash in half lengthways and scoop out the seeds using a teaspoon. Fill the squash with the leek mixture. Pop a sprig of thyme into each one.
3. Bake for 30-40 minutes until the squash is soft and the cheese mixture is bubbling. Delicata squash has been described as a 'sweet potato' squash as the flavour and texture as the flesh is similar to sweet potato.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The month of August is always very quiet, not much happening at all, the next few months we will be working on next year's budgets, will be a challenging time.

Neither have I got anything to report for our area particularly, although there must be, if you have anything, please let me know.

This is a time of significant change and opportunity for English local government as a whole. Despite the government increasing funding for councils over recent years, a combination of high inflation and rising demand has left local authorities facing some of their toughest budgetary decisions to date.

Our Director of Finance Angie Sinclair revealed that the authority finished the 2022/23 financial year £156,000 in the black on a revenue budget of almost £630 million.

But she warned that – in common with councils across the country – Devon continued to face tough financial challenges.

The year since last June has seen all of us gain a better understanding our financial position, stabilising some area of the business which frankly were out of control, when they could/should have been in our control. Surges in service demand, not least in Adult and Children's services make the task more difficult to predict and model financially, but the 'new' corporate Leadership team are clearly all 'rowing' in the same direction, despite events like the cost of living and Ukraine war impacting us, but with no influence over those events.

Last summer Angie Sinclair, Financial Director, warned councillors that Devon faced a £30.5 million overspend with a potential further £10 million on top because of soaring inflation. She called for urgent action to be taken across the authority to curb costs.

Council leaders set up a group of senior officers from every department to go through the budget line by line and identify savings.

An overspend in 2022/23 has been avoided through an organisational-wide response that resulted in a rigorous in-year savings programme.

We currently provide financial support to organisations helping people who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless even though we do not have a statutory responsibility to do so.

The proposal to cut the discretionary spending was originally made to help us balance our books in response to soaring demand for our statutory services.

Our contracts with providers will now be extended until the end of March 2024. In the meantime, we will continue to talk to Devon's eight District and City Councils, working together to agree a way forward that ensures ongoing homelessness support across the county.

Councillor Hart made the announcement having listened to members of the public speak passionately of the impact that the proposed cuts could have on them and others at a special scrutiny committee meeting.

Donna Manson, who is meeting regularly with District Councils' housing services to discuss a way forward.

Our Trading Standards service is reminding businesses, such as takeaways, sandwich bars, care homes and retailers who supply certain single-use plastic items, that a ban comes into force this October, and that they should start thinking now about alternatives and where to source them from.

The ban includes all single-use plastic cutlery, trays, plates, bowls, and balloon sticks, as well as banning the use of certain types of polystyrene cups and food containers used to supply food that is ready to consume.

Devon, Plymouth and Torbay Devolution Deal

The Government has agreed to conclude a devolution deal covering Devon, Plymouth and Torbay this year. The deal will, subject to consultation, see the establishment of a Devon, Plymouth and Torbay Combined County Authority. It will not require a directly elected Mayor nor costly reorganisation of existing councils. Devon's District Councils will have representation on the CCA as will representatives from the business and education sectors. The CCA will have new powers and additional funding from Government to tackle priorities such housing, public transport, jobs, training and skills. Functions and resources of the Heart of the Southwest Local Enterprise Partnership will be folded into the CCA. ray.radford@devon.gov.uk

WILLAND HISTORY GROUP

At our September meeting, History group members enjoyed looking through some of the items recently loaned or donated to the Willand Archive. These included: a set of minute books for Willand Over-60s Club dating from the 1980s; documents relating to the Village Hall; a book about the history of The Gables produced around the time it closed as a Devon County Council run children's 'hostel' in 2003; a detailed map of Willand, its parish boundaries and public rights of way created in 2004; and as well as several items that belonged to Lt-Colonel Jones who lived at Little Knowle in the 'old village', related to his time working in West Africa during the 1940s and 1950s. We would like to thank Jose Spearing, Margaret Dinnage, Brian Holmes, and all those who have contributed material, it is much appreciated. We would also like to remind everyone that we are always interested in anything to do with Willand's past, its businesses, clubs and organisations, and the people who have lived in the parish, and we are interested in anything right into modern times.

Willand Rovers, continues to hold a good league position in the 'Southern League Division One South', the highest level the club has ever reached in the national league system and after winning their first three games were even top. It is worth remembering that Willand was one of the first football clubs in the area, having been established by Dr Tracey in November 1899. The Victorian period saw the development of 'football' under various codes, or sets of rules, especially 'Rugby' and 'Association' football. In the Westcountry, rugby was the most popular from the 1870s, and Association football – then popularly known as 'soccer' was slow to catch on, especially in the Mid Devon area. Westex FC of Tiverton appears to have been the first local team to play 'soccer' regularly (and the occasional game of rugby), from 1899, not long before Dr Tracey started an Association team in Willand. Dr Tracey was the parish's popular doctor, who lived with his family at The Gables; he was renowned throughout the district, not least for his enthusiasm for sporting activities, promoting their health and moral benefits. The Willand Association football club was given a sound foundation, with several local men appointed to the committee, with Albert Chick, parish carpenter and undertaker, as secretary, and Mr Bradbeer, a local builder, as treasurer. R. Richards was the first club captain, with G. Badger vice-captain. Their first game was against Sampford Peverell, which ended in a 1-1 draw: "Badger scored for Willand with a lucky sixty yards kick." There followed home and away fixtures against Tiverton Westex, both of which unfortunately ended in defeat for Willand, 0-1 at home, and 7-0 at Westex, when, "The Willand backs played pluckily, but they could not stop their opponents." Football has continued to be popular in Willand ever since these humble beginnings, and the football club has always been one of the pillars of our community – long may that continue, and the History Group wish Rovers the very best for a successful 2023-24 season. **James Morrison, 01884 250057 (jamorrison235@gmail.com)**

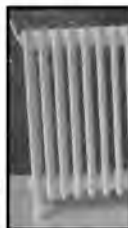
