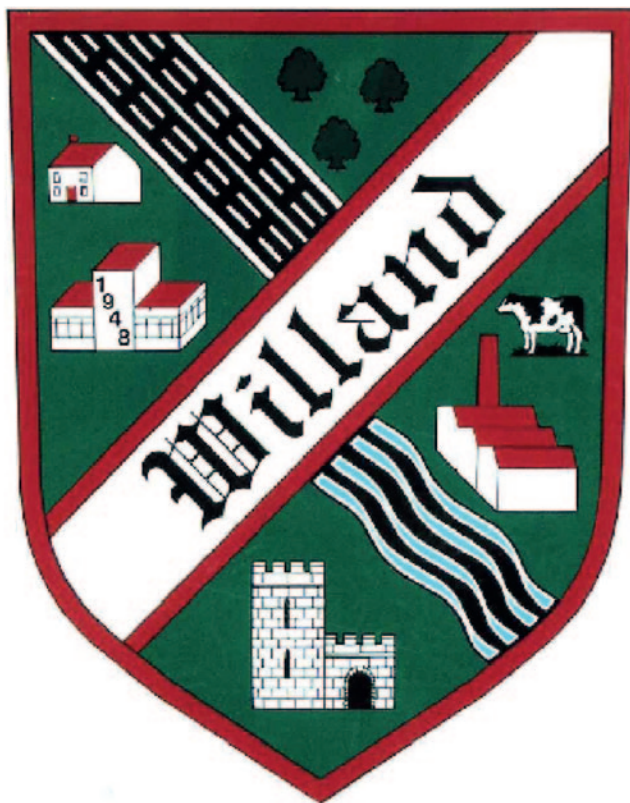

We have been so lucky having **Gerri Taylor** producing our Village magazine with a small team of helpers for the last 6+ years. Gerri is taking a step back now as a new team moves in. Having been copy editor for the last four years I have seen first-hand how dedicated and hard-working Gerri has been to produce a magazine to such a high standard.

The new team will consist of General Editor **Penny Thomas** in charge of advertising and general admin. I **Sam Fincher** will remain as copy editor and talks are ongoing for someone to take over distribution that Gerri is still co-ordinating. Between the three of us we hope to keep up the excellent standard of magazine Gerri has always produced. Thank you, Gerri.

PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S NOTES

Another two months have gone by and there are some notable changes on the political scene after the elections at the beginning of May. We now have three new District Councillors and their details are contained within the magazine. We welcome them and hope that they are able to represent and achieve the wishes of the local electorate within our Parish.

Willand Parish did not have to have an election like our three main towns and some Parishes. We should now have 12 Councillors but only 8 residents put their names forward to represent the Parish and they are all existing councillors. One notable loss to our number is Mrs Frances Wilcox who decided not to stand again. She has been a major worker on the Parish Council but she is also involved in working with a number of other organisations within the village and to be honest you can work a willing horse [person] too much. Frances has realised that something had to give and sadly the loss is to the Parish Council. Frances has offered to continue to help whilst others pick up the tasks she undertook and this is really appreciated. Thank you, Frances for all you have done for the Parish Council and all you continue to do for the benefit of our community.

We have four vacancies on the Parish Council and we are looking to co-opt new members and so if you feel that you can help or would like to know more, please feel free to contact one of the current councillors or Clerk for an informal chat and to obtain more information.

We have also been able to find a new Clerk in Mrs Debbie Bird. She joined us at the beginning of May working alongside Mrs Barbara Bodkin who leaves us for the second time at the end of May. Welcome Debbie and may you have 'staying power'. The email address and telephone number are the same so there should be no problem with contact. As many will recall Barbara came out of retirement to help out as an interim Clerk and we are extremely grateful to her for stepping up as she did. Thank you again Barbara.

Some may have noticed that our grass verges around the village have not been quite so well attended to as in the past few years. Some may be very happy, particularly the bees, to see the grass longer and the dandelions and celandines flowering. There is a downside to this in that with the grass longer when it is cut it makes more of a mess and has the potential to block gutters and the cut grass stays in ridges and rots what is underneath thereby making ideal conditions for more dandelions and weeds to grow rather than grass. We are working on it with the new contractor who does work for other councils and so it is just a case of education into our ways. Any feedback from residents would be appreciated, particularly if constructive.

The refurbishment of the Chestnut Drive play area has been delayed for a short while to resolve a contractual anomaly with the appointed contractor but please rest assured it will happen.

The pump track in the Jubilee Field is still going ahead but the bad weather earlier in the year has put the contractor behind on other projects and he is in the process of catching up. Sadly, it will not be available for use during the school summer holidays.

Some youngsters started digging and altering the current facility and a request for this not to happen on the Parish Website and Facebook page led to some rather unfortunate and ill-informed comments which were critical of the actions taken by the Parish Council, particularly when it was pointed out that these actions were costing the Parish [*in other words you/we Council Tax Payers*].

It may help that now things have calmed down a bit a reasoned explanation may be receivable by those critics. A couple of years or so ago the Parish Council were sued by a parent as he twisted his ankle when jumping off one of the low balance beams in the Jubilee Field that are there for the use of children. There was a small pit in the grass that appeared to have been dug by a dog. Our handyman is forever filling in such holes as they are reported. Our [your] insurers dealt with it but it cost the Parish money even though the equipment was being misused. We are aware that under the mounds of the BMX track is buried a lot of concrete and other potentially dangerous materials. In the past youngsters have exposed these dangers and we [*council tax payers*] had to pay to get it removed as it was exposed. We even had to consider removing the facility completely. In the latest incident which led to the Facebook 'commentators', a safety inspection by a qualified person employed to do monthly inspections of all our play areas, raised the danger potential of what was being done and so it could not be ignored. If someone was injured as the result of the unauthorised works the Parish Council could be liable and our insurers could have possibly not covered any claim. Hopefully this puts it into perspective but if anyone has any concerns or issues, please talk to me or come along to a Parish Council Meeting. On the other hand, if you feel you can do better than those of us who try and serve our community, we have four vacancies on the Parish Council so come and join us.

A Consultant has been appointed and started work towards replacing the skateboard facilities with a more challenging structure but this will be some time away as we have to go through a planning process amongst other 'hoops'.

Volunteers will shortly be tidying up the planters around the village as the new plants become available. We hope that they give some enjoyment to those who see them. Thank you to the volunteers yet again and to The Old Well Garden Centre for being generous with their discounts on the price of the plants.

It is that time of year again where landowners are being asked to cut back shrubs or other growth which is encroaching onto footpaths and the highways. The Parish Council do contact some landowners seeking their cooperation and, in some cases, we have to contact Devon County Highways to use their legal powers. Thank you to all of you who do your bit without being asked and to those who respond positively when being contacted.

What with the Coronation and Eurovision there is much going on to attract people's time and interest but please do not forget to help and support the many clubs and organisations that go on within our community. Thank you to all who contribute in a positive manner for the good of our community.

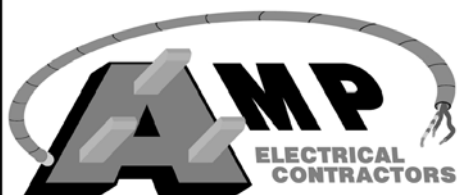

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

Another Council year has just gone, how quick it goes. Things are hectic at County, it has been a challenging year, more so than any previous years, finances are very tight, there are services we have to supply, irrespective of the cost and the government do not allow enough for those services.

As a County Councillor you have to serve on various committees, for me I am on the Corporate Services and Infrastructure some of whose main responsibilities are roads, waste, planning, properties, etc. There are other committees I serve on such as Highways and Traffic Orders Committee (HATOC) and the Canal Advisory Committee.

The sort of financial pressures includes Adult Services and Children and Young People, both of these suck up 79% of available revenue, this is mandatory, we have to do it. Because of the cost of these services, other departments revenues are squeezed.

The Council finds itself in a very challenging internal position in that Children's Services, SEND provision and budget sustainability face serious challenge along with concern from stakeholders regarding confidence in the Council to address these challenges. The continuous failure of the Council to improve the Inadequate judgement by Ofsted of Children's Services over a 12-year period has resulted in the children's minister issuing a Revised Statutory Direction for

social care specifically citing failures of corporate governance and escalating to the appointment of a commissioner to oversee Improvement and hold the Council to account. There is also government intervention for SEND and a material threat of a s114 notice because of the High Needs Block deficit now approaching £130 M. These are serious, failures of the County Council's governance in response the Leader and Chief Executive in meetings with the children's minister have agreed the urgent need for a Review of Corporate Governance as a priority in conjunction with the formal work of the Improvement Boards in Children's Services where oversight of progress is led by the Commissioner appointed by the Minister and the SEND Improvement Board.

The services the Council provide, and the context of delivery have significantly changed; equally so our staff are impacted by these contexts too. In summary the Council finds itself in a very different operating context and the need for a review of priorities is required.

The continuous failure of the Council to be able to improve the Inadequate judgement by Ofsted of Children's Services, has resulted in the children's minister issuing a Revised Statutory Direction for social care specifically corporate governance and escalating to the appointment of a commissioner to oversee improvement and hold the Council to account.

In response the Leader and Chief Executive in meetings with the children's minister have agreed the urgent need for a Review of Corporate Governance as a priority in conjunction with the formal work of the Improvement Boards in Children's Services where oversight of progress is led by the Commissioner appointed by the Minister and the SEND Improvement Board.

The Adult Social Services Budget is £336m per year and the Children and Young People Budget is £233m per year, these are all mandatory, we have to supply the service. This represents almost 80% of our total revenue/income.

Highways for maintenance of Devon roads had gradually fallen from around £35 million in 2012/13 to approximately £25 million in 2022/23. Coupled with inflationary change, in particular the rapid increase in inflation seen in 2022/23, this meant that the maintenance budget had halved in real terms compared to a decade ago.

This also has the knock-on impact of forcing change in priorities with safety taking higher consideration and proactive works being stopped, leading to rapid deterioration of roads. Having said that, the Government have advanced DCC with an extra £9.4m for this coming year, this will help.

It is worth noting that 80% of traffic use 20% of the 8,000miles of Devon's highway.

A well-defined asset management approach enables the County Council to demonstrate it has a clear methodology for valuing highway infrastructure assets and determining their condition. The Plan will be a key document used by the officers, consultants, and contractors enabling the effective management

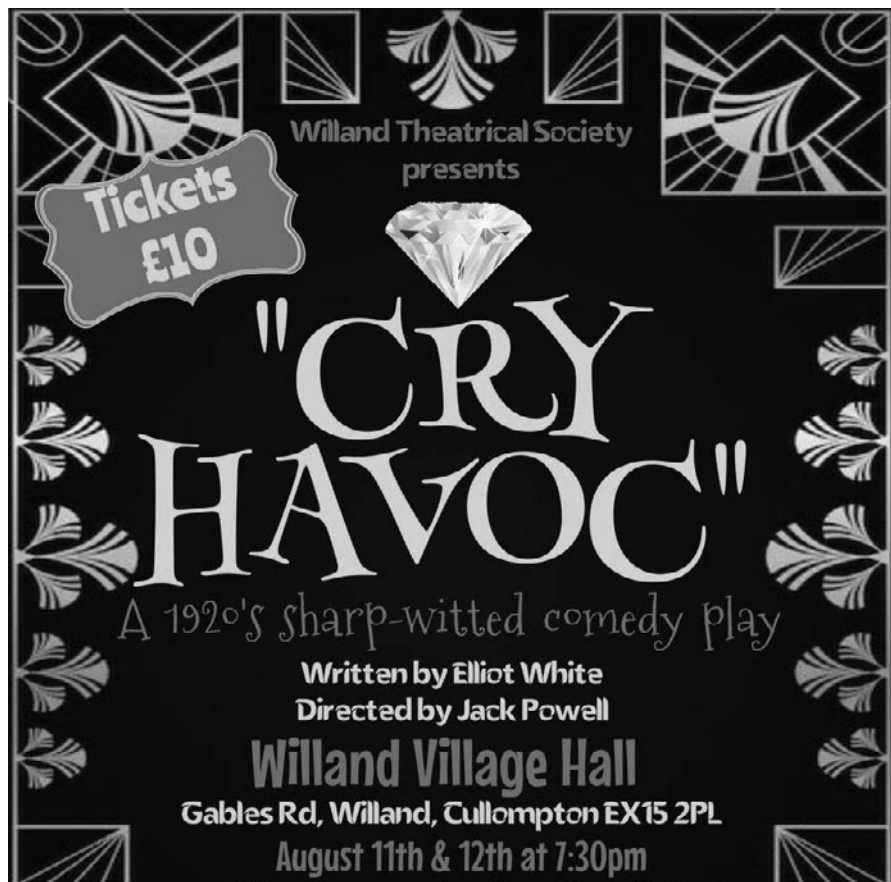

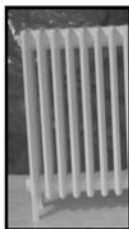

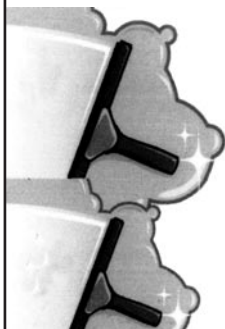

WILLAND HISTORY GROUP

First of all, we would like to thank everybody who contributed memories or memorabilia that featured in our Coronation exhibition – it is all much appreciated. Attendance on the Saturday was disappointing, but it was great to see a good crowd in the Village Hall on the Sunday of Coronation weekend, with lots of happy faces and people enjoying themselves.

One interesting piece of information that came out of research for the exhibition was the story of Willand Playing Field, which was meant 'for the pleasure and recreation of the younger generation' and formally opened by Mrs Tracey to the start of the day's festivities for the Coronation of George VI in 1937. The origin of this scheme was described in a speech by Mr Honeywill, local JP and former stationmaster of Tiverton Junction Railway Station, who said, "The idea of a playing field for Willand originated after the Silver Jubilee [of George V in 1935]. A committee was formed under the chairmanship of their old friend and veteran, Mr Albert Chick, with Mr Little as Hons. treasurer and Mr Holloway as Hons. secretary. The last-named post has certainly been no easy one; Mr Holloway had put a lot of hard work not only into this scheme, but other things at Willand. (Applause). By whist drives and dances £70 was raised, and Willand's first carnival yielded £130. That brought the scheme to fruition earlier than was expected, and the committee were able to rent the Playing Field from the Tiverton Rural District Council. It was the hope of the committee that some beneficent person would in time come forward and give them a bit of land. Meanwhile this field was for the free and unfettered use of all residents of Willand, free of debt and free of rates. (Applause) He hoped parents would encourage their children to use the field, and that all would get full enjoyment out of it.

We recently received a query regarding Bramber Engineering, the engineering company that set up a factory in Willand during the Second World War to escape the bombing of London which threatened their headquarters in Cricklewood. The company went on to maintain a presence in Willand until 2011. Information is being sought about Albert Henry Pearson, who worked for Bramber's until 1964. His grandson is keen to know if anyone can remember Mr Pearson or might have any information about him. If you do, please get in touch with us at Willand History Group, and we would be happy to put you in touch.

Finally, we would like to congratulate our friends at Halberton History Group (HHG), for hosting a successful and fascinating exhibition back in April on Twose, the family business of agricultural machinery makers started in the 1830's by William Twose, the Halberton village blacksmith. The company became 'one of the most illustrious names' in agricultural engineering, with a global reach, and eventually became MST (Medland, Sanders & Twose) of Tiverton, which sadly went into liquidation last year. The story is told an excellent booklet produced by HHG, a testament to some well-kept archives, much treasured local knowledge, and a lot of hard work researching.

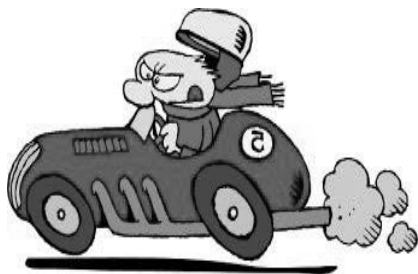
WILLAND COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH (WCSW)

Now that we appear to have decent weather and, of course, the daylight hours are longer, we will be out regularly so, **please stick to the speed limits.**

1182 TONNES OF COMPOST PRODUCED WHICH HAS BEEN BAGGED TO PROVIDE 20,990 BAGS OF SIEVED.

All of this from your garden waste deposited and we processing as compost to be used by you.

We sincerely hope with your continuing support of using your site and providing assistance as “Composters” we will be able to continue. In addition, we have off site jobs – Secretary and Treasurer. Both these will shortly be vacant. This is me doing these roles for 20 years. In return you will have the satisfaction of being an integral member. With full training and support - to those who wish further information, you can contact me (see below). Time required about 4 hours/month.

GREEN COMPOSTING SITE

‘Going green’ for WCCS means that we are asking that you kindly bring green garden waste to the site nothing else. Over the last few months, we have seen quantities of tree and bush pruning left in the bays. This material has had to be removed from the bays and disposed of by non-composting means, contributing in some small measure to air pollution. Not good. So big request – hedge and plant pruning’s up to 1/2” thick ok - with no soil IS GOOD - nothing else - big help. Further information is displayed on notices regarding garden waste on the fence

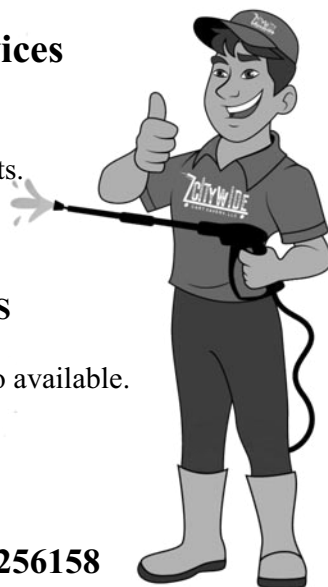
