EDITORIAL 174

Always the bridesmaid, so England lost again, maybe football will come home next time. Nevertheless, we hope you enjoy the rest of the summer and this edition of your magazine.

#### PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S NOTES

Regrettably I have to start this magazine contribution on a sad note. It was with great sadness that the Parish Council learned of the death of former Parish Councillor Anthony George MANDER [Tony].

Tony was a member of the Parish Council for a number of years only retiring when he had to start cutting back on his commitments. He was a Trustee of the Willand Health and Community Centre project from its inception to his death. He was a stalwart of the Composting Group until recently; a supporter of the football club and had interest in many more village events and activities. Rest in Peace Tony – Duty done.

I will try and follow with some good news. As will be seen by those visiting the Jubilee Field, the skate ramp is in the process of being constructed and by the time this article goes to press I hope that it will be completed and in use for the school holidays. There has been some disruption of the footpath, but the contractors have done their best to keep this to a bare minimum. We are also very appreciative of the cooperation and assistance from the Head Teacher and staff of the primary school in permitting access to the site from the school drive. You will note that we are also putting in a footpath to the shelter and bottom of the pump track ramp to try and reduce the mud when it is all very wet.

We are in the process of obtaining quotations for various additional bits of play and fitness equipment around the village play areas. This will have to go through the process of obtaining three quotations and then putting in applications for Mid Devon District Council to release the monies to us, which they already hold, as the result of S106 monies paid by Bellway Homes as the result of their development off Meadow Park. We are considering the following improvements:

Chestnut Drive Play area – addition of a sprung see saw.

Jubilee Field fenced area – replacement see saw; two new goal posts with back and side 'netting' as requested by the youngster to save them having to chase the ball all across the field when they score a goal.

Orchard Way area – enhance the availability of fitness equipment on that side of the village similar to that available in the Jubilee Field. Parallel Bars. Pull up bars, climbing poles, monkey bars, a pan type swing and a small multigym. This will be of use to all ages.

Anyone with views or ideas are asked to share them with the Parish Clerk please.

There have been various comments on social media concerning the work of Community Payback 'volunteers' in clearing various growth in differing sections of Jaycroft.

This work was arranged by Devon County Council Highways Department. Conflicting views have been expressed as to the timing and the need with concerns for nesting birds and plants and wildlife.

To clarify the position the works and the responsibility rests with Devon County Council Highways Department. Hedges can be cut at this time of year but the person(s) responsible have a duty to make sure that there are no nesting birds etc. If anyone has firm evidence that the various sections of the wildlife law has been broken then it should be brought to the attention of the police. In spite of speculation Mid Devon District Council had no input to these works and cannot be blamed for any of it. The only involvement of the Parish Council is that we were told it was to happen and we were asked to make arrangement for welfare facilities with the village hall which we did. A telephone number was given in case of any issues, but no calls were received. The Parish Council did share the information concerning the works with residents via Facebook etc.

There are a number of footpaths which would benefit from work and whereas in previous years, pre Covid and a change of management at the Probation Service, the Parish Council could access 'volunteers' and do this work but now we can only do it via Devon County. They will wash their hands of some areas by saying that the boundary ground belongs to MDDC. One area that is of great

concern at present is the footpath out to the garage after Rowan Lea. The Parish Clerk is trying to contact the farmer but no luck at present. The bottom of the hedge is encroaching over the tarmac as is the grass from the verge. There is little chance of getting DCC Highways to do it as they are not even coping with potholes. DO WE HAVE A SMALL BAND OF RESIDENTS WHO COULD GIVE SOME TIME ON, SAY A SUNDAY MORNING OR TWO, and have a go. I have the tools and



inclination but not the ability now because of health. I can advise and encourage. It would have to be volunteers and at own risk although the Parish Council has some insurance cover for such eventualities. Any takers please contact the Clerk or me direct and we will get something organised.

Thank you to the few who have responded to the survey as to the future issues around the extension to the cemetery. A decision will be made and circulated on the website and a future edition of the magazine. The statutory five year 'topple test' of the gravestones is to be carried out and any problems will be brought to the attention of the relevant families. This is a safety issue as most will appreciate.

Our volunteers have updated the planters around the village, and we are grateful for their continued support. Once again The Old Well Garden Centre has supplied the plants and supported us with a generous discount – thank you.

We still have three vacancies for Parish Councillors in Willand and we can coopt new councillors without the need for an election if appropriate. Please can you think about joining us and helping do the best we can for our community and to keep Willand a nice place to live in. I have now lived here for 34 years and used to police it back in the 1970's so have seen it grow into what it is today.

We need to keep an eye on what is being done by higher authorities which could make things worse for us. Most support and enjoy our community and long may that continue. **Barry G J Warren Chairman** Willand Parish Council.

#### WILLAND HISTORY GROUP

First of all, we would like to thank Geri Holloway for getting in touch with some of her memories of Willand during the Second World War. Geri rightly reminds us that as well as the REME camp in the 'old village' there was an ATS (Auxiliary Territorial Service, the women's branch of the British Army) camp in the fields on the opposite side of the road, between Elm View (which at that time was Tom Sanders' butcher shop) and the boundary wall to Harpitt House. Geri recalls the REME camp, noting that "as well as that camp with its huge hanger-like sheds there were often one or two Bren gun carriers (like small tanks) parked at the top of Dye House Lane alongside the end wall of Carr Cottage, my home, much to the curious delight of us village children."

"What I do recall very clearly is soldiers being billeted in the spacious outbuildings of Townlands, the big, detached house right opposite Carr Cottage and which was sadly demolished several years after the war ... My hospitable parents often befriended those soldiers.

Three come to mind: Dick, a soft-spoken Scot killed at Dunkirk; Tommy with whom my parents kept in touch for several years after the war; and Jordie. During their respective postings to Willand they spent much of their free time in my home, often playing darts with my father. From late evening a sentry was stationed at the wide, unenclosed frontage of the Townlands billet; the high ornamental iron double gates and many yards of iron railings on either side had been commandeered for melting down as part of the war effort. My father used to take a cup of cocoa out to the sentry on duty. Apparently the soldiers drew lots for that particular spell of duty with its welcome hot drink!"

"Despite all the military presence in the village my parents never mentioned or discussed the events of the war itself with me or my sister. Consequently, I was unaware of the actual dates, details and significance of incidents such as Dunkirk, D-Day, battled, bombing raids, etc. The one exception was the three consecutive nights in May 1942 when Exeter, just 15 miles from Willand, was severely bombed: my mother, sister and myself could hear the bombs dropping

on the city as we huddled together under the solid dining room table. My father, a member of the local ARP (Air Raid Precaution) was out in the village – as part of Dad's Army"

From our own Archives we have record of one young Willand man who was a victim of that 'Exeter Blitz' in May 1942. His name was Dennis Bird, aged only 17, who was killed at St David's Railway Station. He had been living at an address in Exeter, but his parents still lived in Willand. And even Willand itself came under aerial 'attack' during the war. We have been told about one time when bombs fell on farmland near Park Farm, which was most likely to have been a German plane jettisoning unused bombs on its on the way back from a raid elsewhere. On another occasion a German plane passing over the village opened fire with its machine guns, strafing the Bramber's factory (now demolished) on South View Road.

Thankfully there were no casualties, but houses on Fir Close were hit by stray bullets – the marks are still there to be seen - and one bullet is reputed to have gone through the canopy of a pram.


